



I would like to start off saying thank you to Yellowknife South for placing your trust in me. I began to carry that trust with me the morning after the election, and I promise that every day I'm going to use my judgement and best efforts to advance the work of the Assembly on behalf of you, Yellowknife South, and the people of the Northwest Territories.

The first 75 days of being your Member have been busy ones. The 19th Assembly started their work on developing how we wanted to see our Assembly structured. It was a goal of the Members to ensure that the 19th Assembly would be one built on relationships and shared priorities. We are of the mindset that we will approach this Assembly thinking critically, looking for new and innovative ways to do things. We also elected a Cabinet who have promised to work with the Regular Members. I was

lucky to be chosen to be a part of that Cabinet; I have taken on the additional responsibilities of being the Minister for Finance and for Justice. This does present its challenges when dealing with Constituency issues, but I want to reassure you that Yellowknife South will continue to be my priority.

In order to keep the lines of communication open to me, part of the first 75 days was spent building up a Constituency Office at the Legislative Assembly, where you are always welcome to come, visit, and most importantly, bring us your concerns and ideas. Sarah Kalnay-Watson is your first point of contact for Yellowknife South and she is ready to help. We've also made it easier for you to get a hold of us or see what we are up to, with multiple email addresses, website submissions, phone numbers, Facebook, Instagram and Twitter. We will also have Constituency Meetings and this newsletter. We're currently planning to have our first Constituency Meeting near the end of January, just before the Budget Session starts. This will be the first of many constituency newsletters, as a priority of mine is to keep you informed and know that I am listening and here for you. - Yellowknife MLAs have begun meeting in order to work together to better serve the people of Yellowknife, who share many of the same issues, and to develop better relationships as a whole with community groups and organisations;
- Sarah and I met with YK1 and Commission scolaire francophone TNO, to discuss their needs and concerns, and have plans to meet with the Yellowknife Catholic School Board early in the new year;
- Spoke at the Stanton Territorial Hospital Foundation Gala;
- Spoke at the Day to Eliminate Violence Against Women conference hosted by Status of Women Council
 of the NWT;



- Traveled to the South Slave (Hay River and Fort Smith) combining introductions to both Justice and Finance to better serve the region and afford the ability to use all my time efficiently;
- Meeting staff throughout the divisions within Justice and Finance, and will be continuing this into the New Year; and
- Traveling to Ottawa to represent the GNWT at a meeting with all Finance Ministers.
